REPORT CARDS HOME TODAY

Neither rain, nor snow, nor dark of night – nor even snow days! – have kept our faculty and staff from completing 2^{nd} Trimester Report Cards and having them ready today! Please look for your child's report card, STAR360 reading update and any other special notes coming home today! Our 2^{nd} Trimester proved to be a bit more challenging for our students, as they progressed from review earlier in the year to new and more challenging content. Despite that, we've got a great showing of honors averages among our 3^{rd} through 8^{th} grade students! 87.2% of all eligible students (grades 3-8) received an award: 38% received High Honors; 22% received Second Honors; and 26% received Merit Honors. Well done, and keep up the good work!

TRANSPORTATION REQUESTS DUE ON APRIL 1st

Parents of Catholic school students must request transportation services directly from the public school district in which they live. The deadline for submitting written requests for transportation is April 1, 2017 for the 2017-2018 school year. Failure to submit a request by this deadline might lead to the suspension of bus privileges for those families. Administrators are urged to remind parents of the necessity of meeting this deadline and to alert parents of prospective new students of this as well.

NYS PROFICIENCY TESTING BEGINS

Our NYS Proficiency testing commences on Tuesday, March 28th. We encourage testing because it helps us to identify those children who may need academic support. It also identifies areas of strength in our curriculum, and areas that we need to augmented in the upcoming year. I want to assure you that <u>our teachers are not evaluated based upon any of this testing</u>, and that participation in testing, in addition to informing us about student needs, the curriculum, and providing an opportunity to "practice" taking a standardized test, also <u>maximizes our NYS funding</u> and affects our school ranking. We are asking for your support in assuring that your child participates in this protocol. <u>Please do not opt out</u>. We make every effort to keep the testing as low-key as is possible, and this year we look forward to a shorter test that is untimed.

If a parent does opt out for a student, we will now be providing <u>alternate testing</u> during NYS test windows. This requires additional scoring time on the part of our teachers, but will still help us to identify those students who require additional academic support.

Any parents who are considering opting their children out are asked to meet in the Cafeteria this coming Monday, March 20th at 6:30 to receive opt-out forms (and receive one final plea to stay the course!). Thank you!




